



Trampoline Routine Checklist

It's important for parents and kids to keep a close eye out for changes in their trampoline before and during each use. However, we know it is unrealistic for thorough checks to happen daily. Making a habit of giving the trampoline a thorough inspection a couple of weeks before each school holidays will ensure the kids will spend their holidays bouncing and not waiting for their spare parts to come in the mail.

Trampoline positioning:

- Trampoline is positioned and stable on a well-levelled surface
- Trampoline is positioned on a soft surface (i.e. not abrasive)
- Trampoline is positioned a minimum of 1.5m away from potential hazards (e.g. walls, fences, clotheslines and trees)
- There is minimum 5m clearance above the trampoline bed
- The space under the trampoline is clear of objects (e.g. toys, bikes, garden tools)

Trampoline frame:

- The frame is in good condition (e.g. not bent, cracked, rusted or corroded)
- Legs are inserted in a secure and locked position
- Joints are in good condition
- No sharp edges are present on the frame
- Trampoline bed (jumping mat)
- Mat is in good condition (e.g. no punctures, tears, holes, sagging or other damage)
- The fabric of stitching around the mat is in good condition

Padding:

- Padding is correctly installed and securely attached to the framework and mat edges
- Padding is in good condition (e.g. no punctures, tears, holes or other damage)
- Stitching of padding fabric is in good condition

Enclosure:

- Enclosure and supports are correctly installed, securely attached and in good condition
- Pole caps are installed and securely attached
- Enclosure is in good condition (e.g. no punctures, tears, holes, sagging or other damage)
- Stitching of enclosure is in good condition
- Enclosure entrance is in good condition and not broken or damage

It's crucial to repair or replace any parts immediately to keep your trampoline as safe as possible.
